

### Locking an Account with GoldKey

Windows 7 and Vista support GoldKey Secure Login, which allows you to lock down an account with GoldKey. Each GoldKey can lock an unlimited number of accounts on any number of computers.

To lock your account with GoldKey, log in and press Control-Alt-Delete. Click on Change a password, and then on Other Credentials. Next, insert your GoldKey and click on Enable GoldKey Login.

You will be required to enter your GoldKey PIN and your current Windows password in order to lock your account. Make sure that “No Group Selected” is shown below your PIN and press Enter.

### Accessing a Locked Account

After you have locked your account, you will be required to use your GoldKey to log in. Insert your GoldKey token and enter your PIN to log into your account.



### Secure Storage in the Cloud

GoldKey provides a service called KryptoVault, which allows you to store your data securely in the cloud. All the data you store in a KryptoVault is encrypted by your GoldKey. All consumer keys have access to certain public Vaults. Please register for a GoldKey Digital ID to obtain a free 30-month subscription for your own KryptoVault storage.
